



## Woods Crampton 'White Label' Clare Valley Riesling 2020

**Grape Variety:** 100% Riesling  
**Winemaker:** Nicholas Crampton & Aaron Woods  
**Closure:** Screwcap  
**Alcohol:** 12.5%



**Summary:** For a small winemaker, Woods Crampton has achieved a lot in a small amount of time. Part of the Barossa new wave, Woods Crampton make contemporary wines, balancing character, complexity and freshness, a world away from the fruit bombs of the past.

**Vineyard:** In 2020 Woods Crampton sourced fruit from a premium Clare Valley vineyard that was a minimum of 15 years old.

**Winemaking:** The fruit was hand harvested early in the morning into small bins before rapid transportation to the winery. Following a chill overnight at seven degrees overnight the fruit was whole bunch pressed. The fermentation was very cool, at around twelve degrees, and allowed to ferment to bone dry. The absence of the influence of solids is crucial to the purity of the style.

**2020 Vintage:** 2020 was a challenging vintage being one of the hottest and driest on record. Windy conditions at flowering meant an uneven fruit set that meant lower yields. Despite lower crops the quality was high and the best examples are shining.

**Tasting Note:** Pale, almost opaque, with vivid green highlights. The nose is very fresh and restrained, showing citrus with subtle floral notes. The palate is elegant and pure, offering glimpses of its potential, with a core of vibrant citrus flavours and beautiful mineral acidity. Perfect with fresh oysters.
