



Road To Enlightenment Shiraz 2018

Summary: Road to Enlightenment is a range of regional and varietally expressive wines seeking to be full flavoured, full of character and exceptionally drinkable. Wines of the past that were too overt in fruit, oak or weight is where we began, the balanced, fresh and vibrant wines of Road to Enlightenment is where we are headed.

Vineyards: Sourced entirely from the Padthaway region to the north of the Limestone Coast in the heart of South Australia's wine county. A combination of two vineyards, each contributing fruit character and richness to the final blend.

Winemaking: Picked in the cool of the morning to retain freshness, the fruit was then destemmed, crushed and sent to stainless steel vessels for fermentation. The wine was partially matured in a combination of stainless steel and second-use French oak before final blending and bottling.

Tasting Note: A lifted nose of blackberry, cherry, tar and spice. A youthful, plump and fruit-filled palate is driven long and fine with supple tannins and fine natural acidity. This wine is full of flavour yet not too heavy, making it a wonderful match to many cuisines.
